



Writing letters: c and o

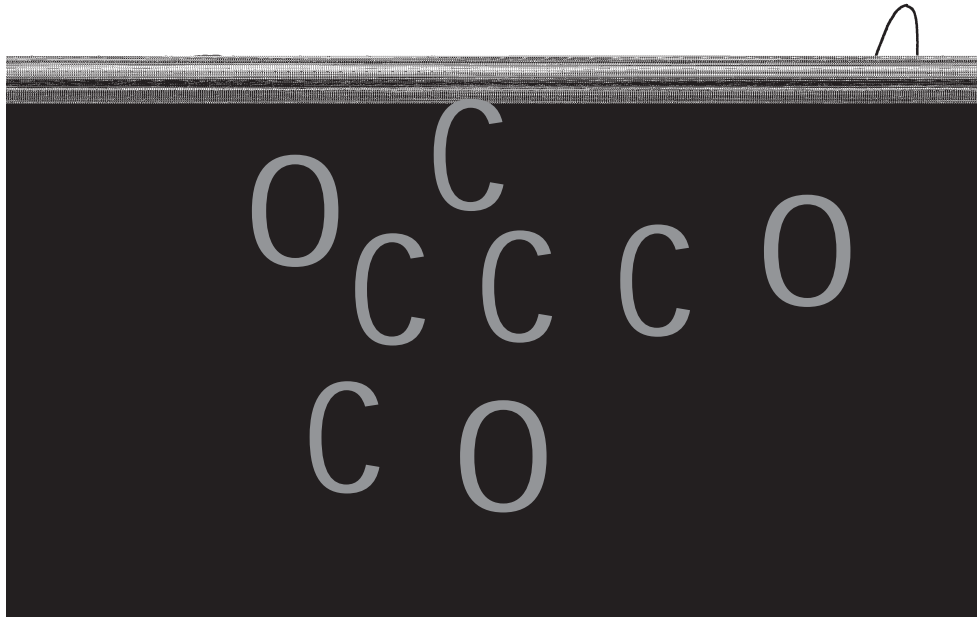
Connect the dots. Start at the big dot, and follow the arrow.

In his exercise, children develop the skill of writing the letter by tracing the letter shape with a finger. For c, start at the top, and then go half a circle; for o, start at the top, and then go all the way around. Help your child to write the letter by beginning with the big dot and following the direction of the arrow (). When writing the letter, call each one by name, reminding your child to use the name of the letter. You can describe each letter more when a child is older or create a story to describe the letter to your child. Describing and talking about the letter helps more when it helps.
