



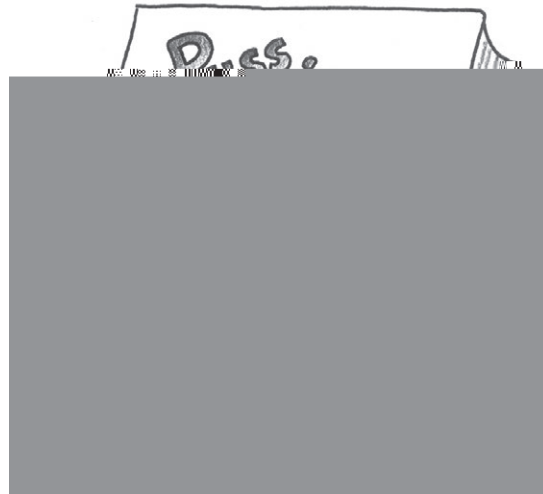
Fiction and nonfiction


